Higher rates of training required in the retail industry

"Spend 85% of your time focusing on the opportunities of tomorrow rather than the problems of yesterday."

Employment, Skills and Training have released the latest findings in the retail industry.

Employees in retail are relatively low skilled with lower average educational attainment than workers in other industries. For example, around 58.7% of workers in retail were without a post-school qualification in 2009, which compares to the all-industry average of 39.5%. Around 20.7% of employees in retail had a Diploma or above and 20.2% had certificate qualifications. By comparison the industry average for workers with a Diploma or above was 37.7% but similar proportion of workers in all industries had certificate qualifications.

The report confirmed that the retail sector in the future will require a more highly skilled workforce including employees with good IT skills who have knowledge of website interface technology to support the move into online retailing. Depending upon the extent that retailers choose to compete on the services they offer rather than primarily the price they charge there may be greater need to develop a workforce with higher customer service skills and longer term commitment to the retail industry.

These skills can be achieved by employers providing higher rates of training to develop relevant skills, the development of incentives to encourage employee productivity, and the pursuit of higher rates of employee retention to capitalise on investment in training.

Student Bonuses paid for Certificate IV Frontline Management

There is an Australian Government Program which provides funding to aged care workers who are studying to enhance their career as a personal care worker, enrolled nurse or a registered nurse.

The qualification must be BSB40807 Certificate IV in Frontline Management and the incentive payments paid directly into the aged care worker's nominated bank account are:

- \$500 on commencement of training
- \$500 on successful completion of the vocational education and training course

This program is being administered by Medicare Australia on behalf of the Dept of Health and Aging as it is a high quality Australian Recognised qualification.

Employer funding...

This qualification is being funded as a Traineeship across all states of Australia, meaning that the Australia government pay employers \$4000 for each staff member to complete a Certificate III or IV level qualification.

There is a qualifying criteria that varies slightly across each state of Australia. Please contact us on info@targettraining.com.au or 1300 736 005 if you would like further details.

This means that the employers have the benefit of upskilling their staff in key disciplines such as:

- Manage themselves and their workload,
- Communicate with team members and management,
